"A"	means the school scored at or above the statewide performance target of 80%.
"B"	means the school did not have a valid 2009 Base API and will not have any target information.
"C"	means the school had significant demographic changes and will not have a target information.
"D"	means this is either an LEA, an Alternative Schools Accountability Model (ASAM) school, or a school with a significant demographic change.

"E"

indicates this was an ASAM school in the 2009 Base API Report and has no information even though the school is no longer an ASAM school.
